Map 2 Empress Group Aquifers

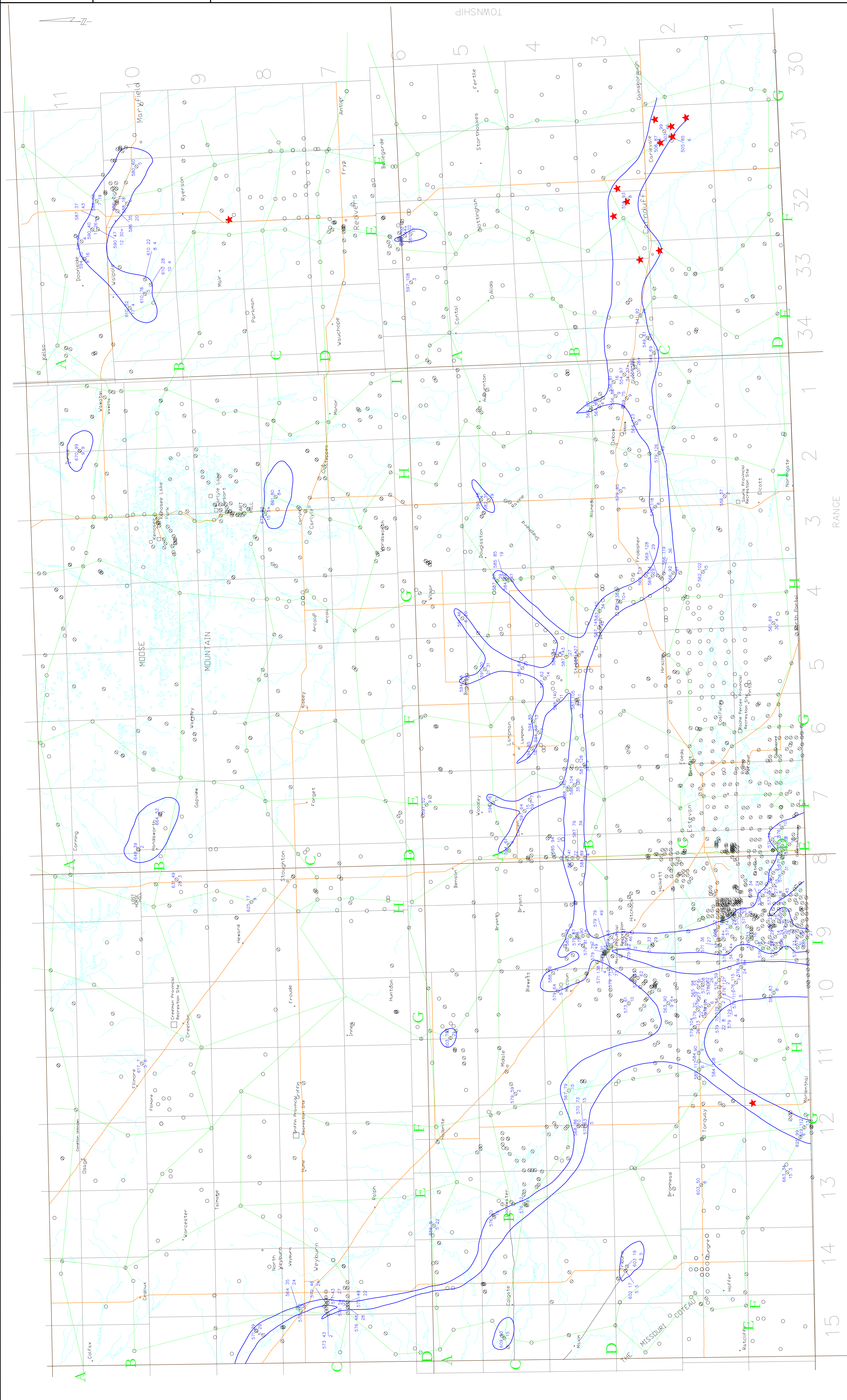

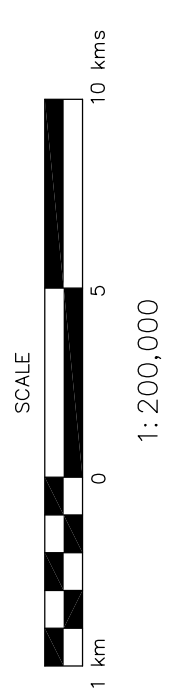
